- 3 FOR the purpose of amending Chapter 543 of the Acts of the General Assembly of

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 Chapter 543 of the Acts of 2000

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 17 MARYLAND, That:
- 18 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 19 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a
- 20 matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either
- 21 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
- 22 unappropriated. [No part of the] THE fund may consist of real property or in kind

- 1 contributions. [No part of the] THE funds may consist of funds expended prior to the
- 2 effective date of this Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching fund
- 3 or what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works
- 4 shall determine the matter and the Board's decision is final. The grantee has until
- 5 June 1, [2002] 2004, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works
- 6 that a matching fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board
- 7 shall certify this fact and the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and
- 8 the proceeds of the loan equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended
- 9 for the purposes provided in this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount
- 10 of the matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be
- 11 of no further effect.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 June 1, 2002.
