A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Motor Carriers - Tax Returns - Identifying Number**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Comptroller to require motor carriers to include  
4 in their tax returns their United States Department of Transportation  
5 identification number in place of an Interstate Commerce Commission  
6 identifying number; and generally relating to identification requirements for  
7 motor carriers.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
9 Article - Tax - General  
10 Section 9-207  
11 Annotated Code of Maryland  
12 (1997 Replacement Volume and 2001 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Tax - General**

16 9-207.

17 (a) Except as provided in § 9-208 of this subtitle, each motor carrier shall:

18 (1) complete, under oath, and file a motor carrier tax return for periods  
19 that the Comptroller requires; and

20 (2) provide other information that the Comptroller considers necessary  
21 to enforce this subtitle properly.

22 (b) To identify properly persons listed in a return, each motor carrier shall  
23 include in the return:

24 (1) the Social Security number or other federal identifying number of the  
25 person; and

1                   (2)       if the Comptroller requires, [the federal Interstate Commerce  
2 Commission identifying] UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (US  
3 DOT) IDENTIFICATION number.

4       SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take  
5 effect October 1, 2002.
