1 (5) an employee who is not a member of a State system and who accepts 2 a position for which the budgeted hours per fiscal year are less than 500 hours in the

3 first fiscal year of employment; OR

4 (6) A NONFACULTY EMPLOYEE OF THE BALTIMORE CITY COMMUNITY 5 COLLEGE WHO BECOMES EMPLOYED ON OR AFTER OCTOBER 1, 2002, OR WHO 6 TRANSFERS TO THE EMPLOYEES' PENSION SYSTEM IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 23-202.1 7 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 8 9 effect October July 1, 2002.
