- 15 (a) The licensing requirements of this title do not apply to:
- 16 A new resident of this State during the first [30] 60 days of residency,
- 17 if:
- 18 (i) The individual has a valid license issued by the state of which
- 19 the individual formerly was a resident;
- 20 (ii) The license authorizes the individual to drive in the state of
- 21 former residence vehicles of the class the individual is driving in this State; and
- 22 (iii) The individual is at least the same age as that required for a
- 23 resident to drive a vehicle of the same class the individual is driving in this State;

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 1 2 effect October 1, 2002.
