A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Driver Licensing - New Residents - Extension of Exemption Period**

3 FOR the purpose of extending the exemption period for new residents to comply with
4 the licensing requirements of the motor vehicle law; and generally relating to
5 the licensing requirements of the motor vehicle law.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Transportation**

14 16-102.

15 (a) The licensing requirements of this title do not apply to:

16 (6) A new resident of this State during the first [30] 60 days of residency,
17 if:

18 (i) The individual has a valid license issued by the state of which
19 the individual formerly was a resident;

20 (ii) The license authorizes the individual to drive in the state of
21 former residence vehicles of the class the individual is driving in this State; and

22 (iii) The individual is at least the same age as that required for a
23 resident to drive a vehicle of the same class the individual is driving in this State;

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
2 effect October 1, 2002.
