1 (ii) The license authorizes the individual to drive in the state of 2 former residence vehicles of the class the individual is driving in this State; and

3 (iii) The individual is at least the same age as that required for a 4 resident to drive a vehicle of the same class the individual is driving in this State;

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 6 effect October 1, 2002.
