Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

17 (e) (5) IN BALTIMORE CITY, THE CIRCUIT COURT IN A PETITION FOR
18 JUDICIAL REVIEW SHALL AFFIRM A DECISION OF THE BOARD OF LIQUOR LICENSE
19 COMMISSIONERS IF:

(I) FOLLOWING A PUBLIC HEARING, THE BOARD IMPOSES A FINE
 ON OR REVOKES OR SUSPENDS AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE OR
 ADULT-ENTERTAINMENT LICENSE FOR A VIOLATION OF THIS ARTICLE, BOARD
 RULES, OR ADULT-ENTERTAINMENT RULES; AND

24 (II) THE CIRCUIT COURT FINDS SUFFICIENT EVIDENCE OF THE 25 VIOLATION IN THE RECORD OF THE PUBLIC HEARING.

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 27 June 1, 2002.
