- 4 FOR the purpose of altering the scope, terms, and conditions of a certain license
- 5 issued by the Baltimore County Board of License Commissioners to make it
- 6 apply only to certain licensees who display and sell certain wine at a wine
- 7 festival; establishing in Baltimore County a special beer festival license;
- 8 specifying certain conditions on licensees, restrictions on display and sale, and
- 9 the scope, fee, and time and location requirements for a special beer festival
- license; requiring the Baltimore County Board of License Commissioners to
- adopt certain regulations; and generally relating to special beer festival licenses
- and special wine festival licenses in Baltimore County.

- 23 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 24 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 25 Article 2B Alcoholic Beverages
- 26 8-304.
- 27 (a) The Baltimore County Board of License Commissioners may issue a
- 28 special [beer and] wine festival license.

- 1 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision to the contrary, an applicant for a
- 2 special [beer and] wine festival license shall be a holder of a requisite existing retail
- 3 alcoholic beverages license issued in the State, [Class 5 brewery license, Class 7
- 4 micro-brewery license, State Class 3 winery license, or State Class 4 winery license
- 5 issued pursuant to this article.
- 6 (c) A special [beer and] wine festival licensee shall only display and sell[:
- 7 (1) Wine] WINE that is produced and processed in Maryland[; and
- 8 (2) Beer that is produced and processed at a Class 5 brewery or a Class 7 9 micro-brewery in Maryland].
- 10 (d) A special [beer and] wine festival license entitles the holder to display and
- 11 sell at retail [beer and] wine for consumption on or off the licensed premises on the
- 12 days and for the hours designated for the special [beer and] wine festival in
- 13 Baltimore County.
- 14 (e) The license fee is \$15.
- 15 (f) The provisions of this section may not prohibit the licensee from holding 16 another alcoholic beverages license of a different class or nature.
- 17 (g) The Baltimore County Board of License Commissioners:
- 18 (1) Except for the dates chosen for the Cumberland and Shenandoah
- 19 Valley Wine Festival in Washington County, the Maryland Wine Festival in Carroll
- 20 County and the Anne Arundel County Beer and Wine [Festival] FESTIVAL, shall
- 21 approve one weekend annually for the special [beer and] wine festival; and
- 22 (2) Shall approve a location in Baltimore County for this festival which
- 23 does not hold an alcoholic beverages license.
- 24 (h) The Baltimore County Board of License Commissioners shall adopt
- 25 regulations for implementing this section.

- 27 (A) THE BALTIMORE COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY 28 ISSUE A SPECIAL BEER FESTIVAL LICENSE.
- 29 (B) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION TO THE CONTRARY, AN
- 30 APPLICANT FOR A SPECIAL BEER FESTIVAL LICENSE SHALL BE A HOLDER OF AN
- 31 EXISTING RETAIL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE ISSUED IN THE STATE, CLASS 5
- 32 BREWERY LICENSE, OR CLASS 7 MICRO-BREWERY LICENSE, ISSUED IN ACCORDANCE
- 33 WITH THIS ARTICLE.
- 34 (C) A SPECIAL BEER FESTIVAL LICENSEE SHALL ONLY DISPLAY AND SELL
- 35 BEER THAT IS PRODUCED AND PROCESSED AT A CLASS 5 BREWERY OR A CLASS 7
- 36 MICRO-BREWERY IN MARYLAND.

- 1 (D) A SPECIAL BEER FESTIVAL LICENSE ENTITLES THE HOLDER TO DISPLAY
- 2 AND SELL AT RETAIL BEER FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR OFF THE LICENSED PREMISES
- 3 ON THE DAYS AND FOR THE HOURS DESIGNATED FOR THE SPECIAL BEER FESTIVAL
- 4 IN BALTIMORE COUNTY.
- 5 (E) THE LICENSE FEE IS \$15.
- 6 (F) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION MAY NOT PROHIBIT THE LICENSEE 7 FROM HOLDING ANOTHER ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE OF A DIFFERENT CLASS 8 OR NATURE.
- 9 (G) THE BALTIMORE COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS:
- 10 (1) EXCEPT FOR THE DATES CHOSEN FOR THE CUMBERLAND AND
- 11 SHENANDOAH VALLEY WINE FESTIVAL IN WASHINGTON COUNTY, THE MARYLAND
- 12 WINE FESTIVAL IN CARROLL COUNTY, AND THE ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY BEER AND
- 13 WINE FESTIVAL, SHALL APPROVE ONE WEEKEND ANNUALLY FOR THE SPECIAL BEER
- 14 FESTIVAL; AND
- 15 (2) SHALL APPROVE A LOCATION IN BALTIMORE COUNTY FOR THIS 16 FESTIVAL WHICH DOES NOT HOLD AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE.
- 17 (H) THE BALTIMORE COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS SHALL
- 18 ADOPT REGULATIONS FOR IMPLEMENTING THIS SECTION.
- 19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 20 June 1, 2002.
