SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

24 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

- 2 8-304.
- 3 (a) The Baltimore County Board of License Commissioners may issue a 4 special [beer and] wine festival license.
- 5 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision to the contrary, an applicant for a
- 6 special [beer and] wine festival license shall be a holder of a requisite existing retail
- 7 alcoholic beverages license issued in the State, [Class 5 brewery license, Class 7
- 8 micro-brewery license,] State Class 3 winery license, or State Class 4 winery license
- 9 issued pursuant to this article.
- 10 (c) A special [beer and] wine festival licensee shall only display and sell[:
- 11 (1) Wine] WINE that is produced and processed in Maryland[; and
- 12 (2) Beer that is produced and processed at a Class 5 brewery or a Class 7 13 micro-brewery in Maryland].
- 14 (d) A special [beer and] wine festival license entitles the holder to display and
- 15 sell at retail [beer and] wine for consumption on or off the licensed premises on the
- 16 days and for the hours designated for the special [beer and] wine festival in
- 17 Baltimore County.
- 18 (e) The license fee is \$15.
- 19 (f) The provisions of this section may not prohibit the licensee from holding
- 20 another alcoholic beverages license of a different class or nature.
- 21 (g) The Baltimore County Board of License Commissioners:
- 22 (1) Except for the dates chosen for the Cumberland and Shenandoah
- 23 Valley Wine Festival in Washington County, the Maryland Wine Festival in Carroll
- 24 County and the Anne Arundel County Beer and Wine [Festival] FESTIVAL, shall
- 25 approve one weekend annually for the special [beer and] wine festival; and
- 26 (2) Shall approve a location in Baltimore County for this festival which
- 27 does not hold an alcoholic beverages license.

- 31 (A) THE BALTIMORE COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY

- 3 (C) A SPECIAL BEER FESTIVAL LICENSEE SHALL ONLY DISPLAY AND SELL
- 4 BEER THAT IS PRODUCED AND PROCESSED AT A CLASS 5 BREWERY OR A CLASS 7
- 5 MICRO-BREWERY IN MARYLAND.
- 6 (D) A SPECIAL BEER FESTIVAL LICENSE ENTITLES THE HOLDER TO DISPLAY
- 7 AND SELL AT RETAIL BEER FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR OFF THE LICENSED PREMISES
- 8 ON THE DAYS AND FOR THE HOURS DESIGNATED FOR THE SPECIAL BEER FESTIVAL
- 9 IN BALTIMORE COUNTY.
- 10 (E) THE LICENSE FEE IS \$15.
- 11 (F) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION MAY NOT PROHIBIT THE LICENSEE
- 12 FROM HOLDING ANOTHER ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE OF A DIFFERENT CLASS
- 13 OR NATURE.
- 14 (G) THE BALTIMORE COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS:
- 15 (1) EXCEPT FOR THE DATES CHOSEN FOR THE CUMBERLAND AND
- 16 SHENANDOAH VALLEY WINE FESTIVAL IN WASHINGTON COUNTY, THE MARYLAND
- 17 WINE FESTIVAL IN CARROLL COUNTY, AND THE ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY BEER AND
- 18 WINE FESTIVAL, SHALL APPROVE ONE WEEKEND ANNUALLY FOR THE SPECIAL BEER
- 19 FESTIVAL: AND
- 20 (2) SHALL APPROVE A LOCATION IN BALTIMORE COUNTY FOR THIS
- 21 FESTIVAL WHICH DOES NOT HOLD AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE.
- 22 (H) THE BALTIMORE COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS SHALL
- 23 ADOPT REGULATIONS FOR IMPLEMENTING THIS SECTION.
- 24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 25 June 1, 2002.
