| 20 21 | (ii) In the year in which the President of the United States is elected, on the first Tuesday in March. |
| 24 | (b) In Baltimore City, there shall be a primary election for municipal offices on the second Tuesday following the first Monday in September in the year [following the election of the Governor] THAT THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES IS ELECTED. |
