1 AN ACT concerning

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## **Natural Resources - Submerged Aquatic Vegetation**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Natural Resources to update certain

- 4 delineations of certain submerged aquatic vegetation protection zones at certain
- 5 times; authorizing a certain area to be opened to certain activities during certain
- 6 times and under certain circumstances; requiring the Department to make
- 7 certain adjustments to certain delineations; requiring the Department to

8 provide certain notice of certain delineations; prohibiting the use of certain gear

- 9 in certain protection zones; providing certain exceptions; defining certain terms;
- 10 and generally relating to the protection and restoration of submerged aquatic
- 11 vegetation.

12 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

# **Article - Natural Resources**

20 4-1006.1.

21 (a) [A person may not use a hydraulic clam dredge in any submerged aquatic22 vegetation bed.

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1 (b) The Department shall:

2 (1) Delineate existing submerged aquatic vegetation beds in the waters 3 of the State not currently protected under Part IV of this subtitle by using the most 4 recent aerial surveys as guidance; and

5 (2) Update as necessary the delineation required under paragraph (1) of 6 this subsection.]

7 (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 8 INDICATED.

9 (2) "AERIAL SURVEY" MEANS THE ANNUAL AERIAL SURVEY COMPILED 10 BY THE VIRGINIA INSTITUTE OF MARINE SCIENCES FOR THE ANNUAL BAY-WIDE 11 SUBMERGED AQUATIC VEGETATION MAPPING PROGRAM.

12 (3) "SAV PROTECTION ZONE" MEANS AN AREA DELINEATED BY THE 13 DEPARTMENT FOR THE PROTECTION FROM UPROOTING AND THE RESTORATION OF 14 SUBMERGED AQUATIC VEGETATION.

15 (B) (1) IN 2004 AND EVERY 3 YEARS THEREAFTER, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
16 UPDATE THE DELINEATIONS OF SAV PROTECTION ZONES THAT WERE COMPLETED IN
17 2001.

THE UPDATED DELINEATIONS SHALL INCLUDE AREAS WHERE
 SUBMERGED AQUATIC VEGETATION HAS BEEN MAPPED BY AERIAL SURVEYS
 DURING AT LEAST 1 OF THE PREVIOUS 3 YEARS.

21 (C) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A
22 PREVIOUSLY DELINEATED SAV PROTECTION ZONE MAY BE OPENED TO THE USE OF
23 THE GEAR SET FORTH IN SUBSECTION (F) OF THIS SECTION DURING AN UPDATE IF:

24 (I) AERIAL SURVEYS HAVE NOT SHOWN ANY SUBMERGED 25 AQUATIC VEGETATION IN THE AREA DURING THE PAST 3 YEARS; OR

26 (II) AERIAL SURVEYS HAVE SHOWN THE DENSITY OF SUBMERGED
27 AQUATIC VEGETATION IN THAT AREA TO BE LESS THAN 10% DURING EACH OF THE
28 PAST 6 YEARS.

(2) THE AREAS IN THE VICINITY OF SMITH ISLAND, SOUTH MARSH
(3) ISLAND, AND BLOODSWORTH ISLAND THAT WERE CLOSED TO HYDRAULIC CLAM
(3) DREDGING IN THE 1999 DELINEATION SHALL BE CLOSED TO THE GEAR SET FORTH IN
(4) SUBSECTION (F) OF THIS SECTION AND MAY NOT BE REOPENED.

33 (D) (1) TO THE EXTENT POSSIBLE, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADJUST SAV
34 PROTECTION ZONES SO THAT DELINEATIONS ARE GEOGRAPHICALLY MANAGEABLE,
35 UTILIZING STRAIGHT LINES AND EXISTING POINTS OF REFERENCE.

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1 (2)(I) TO THE EXTENT POSSIBLE, AN ADJUSTMENT MADE IN 2 ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL RESULT IN NO NET 3 LOSS OR GAIN OF PROTECTED AREA. 4 (II) TO THE EXTENT POSSIBLE, TO PREVENT THE NET LOSS OR GAIN 5 OF PROTECTED AREA RESULTING FROM AN ADJUSTMENT MADE IN ACCORDANCE 6 WITH PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE ADJUSTMENT MAY: 7 1. EXCLUDE SMALL AREAS OF VEGETATED BOTTOM; OR 2. INCLUDE SMALL AREAS OF UNVEGETATED BOTTOM. 8 9 (E) THE DEPARTMENT: 10 (1)MAY UTILIZE BUOYS AS NECESSARY TO MARK SAV PROTECTION 11 ZONES; 12 (2)MAY MAKE REVISIONS TO THE DELINEATIONS OF SAV PROTECTION 13 ZONES AT ANY TIME IF DETERMINED TO BE NECESSARY; AND 14 SHALL PUBLISH, BY PUBLIC NOTICE, DELINEATIONS OF SAV (3)15 PROTECTION ZONES AND REVISIONS TO SAV PROTECTION ZONES. A PERSON MAY NOT USE THE FOLLOWING GEAR IN A SAV PROTECTION 16 (F) 17 ZONE: 18 (1) A HYDRAULIC CLAM DREDGE; 19 A TRADITIONAL BOTTOM DREDGE; AND (2)20 (3) A SHINNECOCK RAKE. 21 This section may not be construed to affect the authority of the [(c)](G)

22 Department to adopt any additional measures that the Department determines are

23 necessary to protect submerged aquatic vegetation beds in the waters of the State.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 25 July 1, 2002.

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
