CHAPTER

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Circuit Courts - Rental of Space for Clerks of Court

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring each State budget to include a certain appropriation to
- 4 the Department of General Services to pay rent to counties, including Baltimore
- 5 City, for certain space occupied by clerks of the circuit courts; establishing the
- 6 amount of the rent; prohibiting reimbursement of certain costs; prohibiting a
- 7 county from decreasing the square footage allocated to the clerk of the circuit
- 8 court below a certain amount, unless the county and the Administrative Office
- 9 of the Courts agree otherwise; requiring counties to use the savings resulting
- 10 from this Act for the circuit courts or related public safety purposes; requiring
- certain reports on certain expenditures; providing for the construction of this
- Act; providing for a delayed effective date; and generally relating to rental of
- space for clerks of the circuit courts.

- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

- 3 (A) THERE SHALL BE INCLUDED IN EACH STATE BUDGET AN APPROPRIATION
- 4 TO THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT NECESSARY
- 5 TO PAY RENT DIRECTLY TO COUNTIES FOR SPACE OCCUPIED IN COUNTY FACILITIES
- 6 BY CLERKS OF THE CIRCUIT COURTS, AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.
- 7 (B) THE RENT SHALL BE \$10 PER NET USABLE SQUARE FOOT, WITH NO
- 8 ADDITIONAL REIMBURSEMENT OF MAINTENANCE AND UTILITY COSTS.
- 9 (C) UNLESS THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS AND A COUNTY
- 10 AGREE OTHERWISE, THE COUNTY MAY NOT DECREASE THE NET USABLE SQUARE
- 11 FOOTAGE ALLOCATED TO THE CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR THE COUNTY
- 12 BELOW THE NET USABLE SQUARE FOOTAGE ALLOTTED FOR FISCAL YEAR 2002.
- 13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, except as expressly
- 14 provided in this Act, this Act does not modify any existing duty, liability, or
- 15 responsibility of the State, a county, or Baltimore City.
- 16 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:
- 17 (1) Beginning in fiscal year 2003 2004 and each fiscal year thereafter, each
- 18 county and Baltimore City shall use the savings resulting from this Act solely to
- 19 increase local expenditures for the circuit courts or related public safety purposes;
- 20 (2) In fiscal years 2003 2004 through 2010, each county and Baltimore
- 21 City shall report to the Department of Budget and Management on or before
- 22 November 1 on circuit court or related public safety expenditures to which the savings
- 23 resulting from this Act have been applied. The Department of Budget and
- 24 Management shall report these expenditures to the Chief Judge of the Court of
- 25 Appeals and, subject to § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, to the General
- 26 Assembly; and
- 27 (3) Circuit court or related public safety expenditures required under this
- 28 section shall be used to supplement and may not supplant existing local expenditures
- 29 for the same purpose.
- 30 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 31 July 1, 2002 <u>2003</u>.
