- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 17 Article Labor and Employment
- 18 3-801.
- 19 (a) In this subtitle, "employer" means a person engaged in a business,
- 20 industry, profession, trade, or other enterprise in the State.
- 21 (b) "Employer" includes:
- 22 (1) a unit of State or local government that employs individuals who are
- 23 not subject to the provisions of Title 9, Subtitle 5 of the State Personnel and Pensions

- 1 (2) a person who acts directly or indirectly in the interest of another 2 employer with an employee.

- 4 (a) This subtitle applies to an employer who provides leave with pay to an 5 employee following the birth of the employee's child.
- 6 (b) An employer who provides leave with pay to an employee following the 7 birth of the employee's child shall provide the same leave with pay to an employee 8 when a child is placed with the employee for adoption.

## Chapter 503 of the Acts of 1999

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 11 July 1, 1999. It shall remain effective for a period of three years and, at the end of
- 12 June 30, [2002] 2006, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this
- 13 Act shall be abrogated and no further force and effect.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 15 July 1, 2002.
