10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

Chapter 260 of the Acts of 2000

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That:

15 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the

16 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a

17 matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either

18 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or

19 unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of real property or in kind

20 contributions. The fund may consist of funds expended prior to the effective date of

21 this Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money

 $22\;$ or assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine

23 the matter and the Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1, [2002]

1 2003, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching

2 fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this

3 fact and the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of

4 the loan equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes

5 provided in this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching

6 fund certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further 7 effect.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 June 1, 2002.
