A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2                                   **Public Schools - Certificated Teachers - Reconstitution Schools or**  
3                                   **Reconstitution-Eligible Schools**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting an individual from teaching in a school that has been  
5 identified as a reconstitution school or reconstitution-eligible school unless the  
6 individual has been issued a certain certificate from the State Board of  
7 Education; and generally relating to the certification of teachers in schools that  
8 have been identified as reconstitution or reconstitution-eligible schools.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 6-115.

18 AN INDIVIDUAL MAY NOT TEACH IN A SCHOOL THAT HAS BEEN IDENTIFIED BY  
19 THE STATE BOARD AS A RECONSTITUTION SCHOOL OR A  
20 RECONSTITUTION-ELIGIBLE SCHOOL UNLESS THE INDIVIDUAL HAS BEEN ISSUED  
21 AN APPROPRIATE CERTIFICATE BY THE STATE BOARD.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
23 October 1, 2002.
