3 (6) (7) "Weighted enrollment growth" means the product of 0.2 times

4 the change in the 4-year average annual full-time equivalent enrollment from the

5 3rd through the 6th prior school years to the 2nd through the 5th prior school years

6 divided by the 4-year average annual full-time equivalent enrollment from the 3rd7 through the 6th prior school years.

8 (b) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, the Maryland School

9 for the Blind shall receive an appropriation equal to or greater than the sum of:

10 (1) 75% of the prior year appropriation multiplied by the product of:

(i) The sum of the weighted enrollment growth plus one; and

12 (ii) The sum of the growth in the per pupil basic current expense 13 figure plus one; [and]

14 (2) 25% of the prior year appropriation multiplied by the sum of the 15 weighted enrollment growth plus one; AND

16 (3) THE INCREASE IN PERSONNEL COSTS FOR TEACHERS AND 17 PROFESSIONAL PERSONNEL PAID UNDER THE BALTIMORE COUNTY SALARY SCALE 18 FROM THE FIRST TO THE SECOND PRIOR YEARS.
