12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

16 (d) (1) (i) In Baltimore City, the Sheriff shall receive an expense
17 allowance of \$1,000 per year and a salary of:

- 18 1. \$62,000 in calendar year 1999;
- 19 2. \$64,000 in calendar year 2000;
- 20 3. \$67,000 in calendar year 2001; and
- 21 4. \$70,000 in calendar year 2002 and thereafter.
