A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Military Service Members

- 3 FOR the purpose of providing for a certain deferral of payment of certain property
- 4 taxes for certain members of the Maryland National Guard and certain
- 5 members of the armed forces of the United States; providing that a certain lien
- 6 will not attach until a certain time; providing that during a certain deferral
- 7 period, interest does not accrue and penalties may not be assessed for certain
- 8 property taxes; providing that the drivers' licenses of certain members of the
- 9 Maryland National Guard and certain members of the armed forces of the
- 10 United States and their dependents shall remain in full force and effect until 60
- days following the licensees' return to the State; requiring the Maryland Higher
- 12 Education Commission to refund certain tuition and fees to certain members of
- the Maryland National Guard and certain members of the armed forces of the
- 14 United States under certain circumstances; and generally relating to certain
- 15 military service members.

- 26 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 27 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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Article - Tax - Property

- 3 (A) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBTITLE 1 OF THIS TITLE. PAYMENT OF PROPERTY
- 4 TAX SHALL BE DEFERRED AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION FOR REAL PROPERTY
- 5 OCCUPIED AS THE PRINCIPAL RESIDENCE OF AN OWNER WHO IS:
- 6 (1) A MEMBER OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES THAT IS 7 ABSENT FROM THIS STATE ON ACTIVE DUTY; OR
- 8 (2) A MEMBER OF THE MARYLAND NATIONAL GUARD WHEN CALLED UP
- 9 FOR ACTIVE DUTY EITHER BY THE U.S. CONGRESS. THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED
- 10 STATES, OR THE GOVERNOR UNDER TITLE 10 OR TITLE 32 OF THE UNITED STATES
- 11 CODE, OR STATE ACTIVE DUTY ORDERS FOR 14 OR MORE CONSECUTIVE DAYS.
- 12 (B) AN OWNER IS ELIGIBLE FOR A PAYMENT DEFERRAL UNDER SUBSECTION
- 13 (A) OF THIS SECTION IF, DURING THE PERIOD THE PROPERTY TAX IS NORMALLY DUE
- 14 AND MAY BE PAID WITHOUT INTEREST AND PENALTY, THE OWNER OR AT LEAST ONE
- 15 OF THE OWNERS IS ON ACTIVE DUTY OUTSIDE OF THIS STATE AS A MEMBER OF THE
- 16 ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES OR IS A MEMBER OF THE MARYLAND
- 17 NATIONAL GUARD WHO HAS BEEN CALLED UP FOR ACTIVE DUTY EITHER BY THE U.S.
- 18 CONGRESS, THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, OR THE GOVERNOR UNDER
- 19 TITLE 10 OR TITLE 32 OF THE UNITED STATES CODE, OR STATE ACTIVE DUTY ORDERS
- 20 FOR 14 OR MORE CONSECUTIVE DAYS.
- 21 (C) PROPERTY TAX DEFERRED UNDER THIS SECTION INCLUDES COUNTY,
- 22 MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICT, AND STATE PROPERTY TAX.
- 23 (D) THE PROPERTY TAX DEFERRAL UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL LAST UNTIL
- 24 90 DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF THE ELIGIBLE OWNER'S RETURN TO THIS STATE, THE
- 25 END OF THE MEMBER'S ACTIVE DUTY STATUS OR THE MEMBER'S DISCHARGE OR
- 26 SEPARATION FROM THE SERVICE, WHICHEVER OCCURS FIRST.
- 27 (E) PROPERTY TAX DEFERRED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY BE PAID WITHOUT
- 28 INTEREST OR PENALTY ON OR BEFORE 120 DAYS AFTER THE ELIGIBLE OWNER'S
- 29 RETURN TO THIS STATE, THE END OF THE MEMBER'S ACTIVE DUTY STATUS, OR THE
- 30 MEMBER'S DISCHARGE OR SEPARATION FROM THE SERVICE, WHICHEVER OCCURS
- 31 FIRST.
- 32 (F) A LIEN IN THE AMOUNT OF ALL DEFERRED TAXES AND INTEREST DOES
- 33 NOT ATTACH UNTIL THE END OF THE DEFERMENT PERIOD.

- 36 (d) (1) A license SHALL REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT IF held by:

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3	(I) [a] A member of the armed forces of the United States who is absent from this State on active service in the armed forces of the United States, or a dependent of the member who is residing with the member outside the [State, shall remain in full force and effect during such absence] STATE; OR
7 8	(II) A MEMBER OF THE MARYLAND NATIONAL GUARD WHO HAS BEEN CALLED UP FOR ACTIVE DUTY EITHER BY THE U.S. CONGRESS, THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, OR THE GOVERNOR UNDER TITLE 10 OR TITLE 32 OF THE UNITED STATES CODE, OR STATE ACTIVE DUTY ORDERS FOR 14 OR MORE CONSECUTIVE DAYS.
12	(2) The license also shall remain in effect, if it would otherwise have expired under this section, for a period of [30] 60 days following the date of the licensee's return to this State, THE END OF THE MEMBER'S ACTIVE DUTY STATUS, or the member's discharge or separation from active service:
16	(i) If the licensee has in the licensee's immediate possession, together with the licensee's driver's license, papers indicating the member's active service outside this State, THE MEMBER'S STATE ACTIVE DUTY ORDERS, or the member's discharge or separation; and
18 19	(ii) If the license is not otherwise suspended, revoked, or canceled under this title during the [30-day] 60-DAY period.

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Maryland Higher Education Commission shall refund the tuition and fees for the 2001/2002 academic year of students who are members of the Maryland National Guard who have been called up for active duty either by the U.S. Congress, the President of the United States, or the Governor under Title 10 or Title 32 of the United States Code, or State active duty orders for 14 or more consecutive days, or members of the armed forces of the United States and who have been called to active duty outside the United States and who are unable to complete their course requirements because of military operations occurring outside of the United States. This refund shall apply only to students who are Maryland residents attending public institutions of higher education in this State.
