AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act is</u> 36 <u>contingent on the receipt by the Motor Vehicle Administration of sufficient federal</u> 37 <u>funds to pay the Administration's initial start-up costs for computer programming</u> 38 <u>changes necessary to implement the requirements of Section 1 of this Act related to the</u> 39 <u>reporting of information to the Selective Service Administration.</u>

- 3 purposes stated in Section 2 of this Act and shall report promptly to the Department of
- 4 Legislative Services when federal funds have been received by the Administration and
- 5 the contingency specified in Section 2 of this Act has been fulfilled.
