FOR the purpose of requiring that certain community colleges receive additional unrestricted grants in certain years; requiring that certain unrestricted grant amounts increase by the same percentage as the percentage increase in funding per full time equivalent student at certain public institutions of higher education in the State providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to unrestricted grants to community colleges.

16 (4) The grant amounts specified in {paragraph} PARAGRAPHS(2) AND 17 (3) of this subsection shall increase in fiscal year 2004 and each fiscal year thereafter 18 by the same percentage as the percentage increase in funding per full-time 19 equivalent student to the 4-year public institutions of higher education in the State, 20 as designated by the Commission for the purpose of administering the Joseph A. 21 Sellinger Program under Title 17 of this article in that fiscal year.			
SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2002.			
SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2002. It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of June 30, 2005, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
