A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Alcoholic Beverages - Family Beer and Wine Facility Permit - Fees**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the issuance and renewal fee for a family beer and wine  
4 facility permit to a certain amount; and generally relating to the family beer and  
5 wine facility permit.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
7 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages  
8 Section 2-101(b)(1)(i)  
9 Annotated Code of Maryland  
10 (2001 Replacement Volume)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

14 2-101.

15 (b) (1) (i) The Office of the Comptroller shall collect a fee for the issuance  
16 or renewal of the following permits:

17 1. \$50 for a solicitor's permit, an individual storage permit,  
18 or a commercial nonbeverage permit;

19 2. \$75 for a public storage permit, a public transportation  
20 permit, or an import and export permit;

21 3. \$100 for a public storage and transportation permit, a  
22 nonresident dealer permit, or a bulk transfer permit; and

23 4. [~~\$400~~] \$200 for a family beer and wine facility permit.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take  
25 effect October 1, 2002.
