- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

- 15 The Office of the Comptroller shall collect a fee for the issuance (b) (1) (i) 16 or renewal of the following permits:
- 17 1. \$50 for a solicitor's permit, an individual storage permit,
- 18 or a commercial nonbeverage permit;
- 19 \$75 for a public storage permit, a public transportation
- 20 permit, or an import and export permit;
- 21 \$100 for a public storage and transportation permit, a 3.
- 22 nonresident dealer permit, or a bulk transfer permit; and
- 23 4. [\$400] \$200 for a family beer and wine facility permit.
- 24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
