## 2 Worcester County - Ocean City Visitors and Information Center Loan of 2000

- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the use of funds in Chapter 641 of the Acts of the General
- 4 Assembly of 2000, Worcester County Ocean City Visitors and Information
- 5 Center Loan of 2000, to allow renovation; extending the date by which the
- 6 grantee is required to provide a matching fund, from June 1, 2002 to June 1,
- 7 2004; and generally relating to the Worcester County Ocean City Visitors and
- 8 Information Center Loan of 2000.
- 9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
- 10 Chapter 641 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2000
- 11 Section 1(3) and (5)
- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 14 Chapter 641 of the Acts of 2000

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That:
- 17 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 18 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 19 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 20 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 21 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 22 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Directors of The Ocean City,
- 23 Maryland Chamber of Commerce, Inc. (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the
- 24 grantee") for the planning, design, construction, RENOVATION, and capital equipping
- 25 (including furnishing) of the Ocean City Visitors and Information Center, to be located
- 26 in Worcester County.
- 27 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 28 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a
- 29 matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either
- 30 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or

- 1 unappropriated. The fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds
- 2 expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount
- 3 of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the
- 4 Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the Board's decision is final.
- 5 The grantee has until June 1, [2002] 2004, to present evidence satisfactory to the
- 6 Board of Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence
- 7 is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and the amount of the matching fund to
- 8 the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan equal to the amount of the matching
- 9 fund shall be extended for the purposes provided in this Act. Any amount of the loan
- 10 in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works
- 11 shall be canceled and be of no further effect.
- 12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 June 1, 2002.
