3 1 4 5 6 7 8 9 10	FOR the purpose of authorizing the Baltimore City Board of License Commissioners to issue a supplemental alcoholic beverages license authorizing certain Sunday sales to a Class D beer, wine and liquor licensee; establishing an annual fee for the supplemental license; requiring a supplemental licensee to notify the Board a certain amount of time in advance of exercising the privileges under the supplemental license; clarifying the hours and days for sale for a Class D beer, wine and liquor license in Baltimore City; making a stylistic change; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to Sunday sales for Class D beer, wine and liquor licensees in Baltimore City.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

23 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 1 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

- 2 6-401.
- 3 (a) (1) A Class D beer, wine and liquor license shall be issued by the license
- 4 issuing authority of the county in which the place of business is located. It authorizes
- 5 the holder to keep for sale and sell all alcoholic beverages at retail at the place
- 6 described in it, for consumption on the premises or elsewhere. A license may not be
- 7 issued for any drugstore.
- 8 (2) The annual license fee shall be paid to the local collecting agent
- 9 before any license is issued, for distribution as provided.
- 10 (3) In this section, "Board" means the Board of License Commissioners
- 11 for the jurisdiction to which the subsection applies.
- 12 (d) (1) [In] SUBJECT TO § 11-503(B)(2) OF THIS ARTICLE, IN Baltimore City
- 13 the annual license fee is \$687.50.
- 14 (2) IN BALTIMORE CITY, THE HOURS AND DAYS FOR SALE FOR THE
- 15 LICENSE ARE AS PROVIDED UNDER § 11-503 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 16 11-503.
- 17 (a) In Baltimore City an amusement license shall authorize the holder thereof
- 18 to keep for sale and sell all alcoholic beverages at all hours except between the hours
- 19 of 2 o'clock a.m. and 6 o'clock a.m. of each day.
- 20 (b) (1) [No] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION,
- 21 NO sales shall be [permitted] ALLOWED by the holder of a Class D, beer, wine and
- 22 liquor license (without amusement permit) between the hours of 1 a.m. on Sunday
- 23 and 6 a.m. the following day.
- 24 (2) (I) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE A SUPPLEMENTAL LICENSE TO A
- 25 HOLDER OF A CLASS D BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE AUTHORIZING THE
- 26 HOLDER TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 6 A.M. ON
- 27 SUNDAY AND 1 A.M. THE FOLLOWING DAY UP TO TWO TIMES DURING ANY CALENDAR
- 28 YEAR.
- 29 (II) THE ANNUAL FEE FOR THE SUPPLEMENTAL LICENSE IS \$150,
- 30 WHICH FEE IS IN ADDITION TO THE ANNUAL FEE FOR THE UNDERLYING CLASS D
- 31 BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE.
- 32 (III) A HOLDER OF A SUPPLEMENTAL LICENSE UNDER THIS
- 33 PARAGRAPH SHALL NOTIFY THE BOARD AT LEAST 2 WEEKS IN ADVANCE OF
- 34 EXERCISING THE PRIVILEGES UNDER THE SUPPLEMENTAL LICENSE.
- 35 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
- 36 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety,
- 37 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members

- $1\,$  elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from  $2\,$  the date it is enacted.
