- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (A) IN BALTIMORE CITY, A HOLDER OF ANY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE
- 19 MAY NOT ALLOW A PERSON UNDER THE AGE OF 21 YEARS TO BE ON THE PREMISES
- 20 AFTER MIDNIGHT, UNLESS:
- 21 (1) THE PERSON IS AN EMPLOYEE OF THE LICENSE HOLDER;
- 22 (2) IN A CLASS B LICENSE FOR USE IN A RESTAURANT OR HOTEL THAT IS
- 23 EQUIPPED WITH A BAR WHERE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE SERVED, THE PERSON IS
- 24 SEATED AT A TABLE AWAY FROM THE BAR; OR
- 25 (3) THE PERSON IS ATTENDING A CONTEST BETWEEN PROFESSIONAL
- 26 SPORTS TEAMS.
- 27 (B) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT TO:

- $1 \hspace{1.5cm} (1) \hspace{1.5cm} \text{FOR A FIRST VIOLATION, A CIVIL PENALTY OF NOT MORE THAN $500} \hspace{1.5cm} 2 \hspace{1.5cm} \text{OR LICENSE SUSPENSION OR BOTH; AND}$
- 3 (2) FOR A SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION, A CIVIL PENALTY OF NOT MORE 4 THAN \$3,000 OR LICENSE SUSPENSION OR BOTH.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 July 1, 2002.
