1 AN ACT concerning

2 Natural Resources - Black Bear Management

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Secretary of Natural Resources to adopt regulations
- 4 establishing a limited black bear hunting season under certain circumstances;
- 5 requiring the Secretary to adopt certain regulations by a certain date; providing
- for the distribution of certain revenues; authorizing the Department of Natural
- Resources to take certain actions relating to the control of the black bear
- 8 population; providing that a certain criminal penalty does not apply in certain
- 9 circumstances; requiring that a certain minimum percentage of black bear
- 10 hunting stamps shall be awarded in a certain manner; requiring
- implementation of certain regulations by a certain date; defining a certain term;
- and generally relating to the control of the black bear population.

- 1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 2 MARYLAND, That Section(s) 10-101(b) through (bb), respectively, of Article -
- 3 Natural Resources of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s)
- 4 10-101(c) through (cc), respectively.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland
- 6 read as follows:

7 Article - Natural Resources

- 8 10-101.
- 9 (B) "CARRYING CAPACITY" MEANS THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF A SPECIES 10 THAT CAN BE SUPPORTED BY A GIVEN HABITAT.
- 11 10-423.
- 12 (a) Any penalty imposed under this section does not apply to an individual
- 13 who kills or wounds a black bear in defense of the individual's own life, the lives of
- 14 other individuals, or the lives of animals on the individual's property.
- 15 (b) A PENALTY IMPOSED UNDER THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO AN
- 16 INDIVIDUAL WHO KILLS OR WOUNDS A BLACK BEAR IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 10-426
- 17 OF THIS SUBTITLE AND THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER § 10-426 OF THIS
- 18 SUBTITLE.
- 19 (C) If the Secretary adopts any regulation, including an emergency regulation,
- 20 under § 10-205 of this title or § 10-405 of this subtitle to prohibit the hunting,
- 21 possessing, selling, purchasing, shipping, carrying, transporting, or exporting of black
- 22 bears, a person who violates the regulation is subject to the following penalties:
- 23 (1) For a first offense, a fine not exceeding \$1,500, imprisonment not
- 24 exceeding 6 months, or both and suspension of the person's hunting license and right
- 25 to hunt any bird or game animal for a period of time not exceeding 2 years; and
- 26 (2) For a second or subsequent offense, a fine not exceeding \$2,000,
- 27 imprisonment not exceeding 1 year, or both and suspension of the person's hunting
- 28 license and right to hunt any bird or game animal for a period of time not exceeding
- 29 4 years.

- 31 (A) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FINDS THAT DUE TO THE EFFECT OF THE
- 32 INCREASING BLACK BEAR POPULATION ON AGRICULTURAL OPERATIONS AND ON
- 33 PRIVATE PROPERTY IN MARYLAND, PARTICULARLY IN THE TWO WESTERNMOST
- 34 COUNTIES, IT IS IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST TO IMPLEMENT THE RECOMMENDATIONS
- 35 OF THE 1995 BLACK BEAR CITIZENS TASK FORCE THAT WAS ASSEMBLED BY THE
- 36 DEPARTMENT TO ADDRESS THE MANAGEMENT AND CONTROL OF NUISANCE BEARS.

- 1 (B) ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2002, THE SECRETARY SHALL ADOPT 2 REGULATIONS TO:
- 3 (1) ESTABLISH, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS
- 4 SECTION, A LIMITED BLACK BEAR HUNTING SEASON TO CONTROL THE BLACK BEAR
- 5 POPULATION IN A REGION WHERE THE BLACK BEAR POPULATION EXCEEDS THE
- 6 REGION'S CARRYING CAPACITY; AND
- 7 (2) REQUIRE THAT, NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS
- 8 TITLE, MONEY GENERATED FROM THE SALE OF LOTTERY CHANCES OR BLACK BEAR
- 9 HUNTING STAMPS BE CREDITED TO THE STATE WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AND
- 10 PROTECTION FUND.
- 11 (C) IN ESTABLISHING A LIMITED BLACK BEAR HUNTING SEASON UNDER
- 12 SUBSECTION (B)(1) OF THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT MAY:
- 13 (1) REGULATE THE TIME PERIOD AND LOCATIONS WHERE BLACK BEAR
- 14 HUNTING IS ALLOWED;
- 15 (2) ESTABLISH THE NUMBER OF BLACK BEAR HUNTING STAMPS ISSUED,
- 16 AT A LEVEL NECESSARY TO CONTROL THE BLACK BEAR POPULATION;
- 17 (3) OPERATE A LOTTERY WHEREBY AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HOLDS A
- 18 VALID LICENSE ISSUED UNDER § 10-301(F)(1)(I), (II), OR (III), (2), OR (3) OR § 10-303 OF
- 19 THIS TITLE MAY PURCHASE A CHANCE TO COMPETE FOR A BLACK BEAR HUNTING
- 20 STAMP;
- 21 (4) REQUIRE THAT THE FEE IS NONREFUNDABLE IF THE APPLICANT
- 22 DOES NOT OBTAIN A BLACK BEAR HUNTING STAMP;
- 23 (5) REQUIRE THAT IF AN INDIVIDUAL OBTAINS A BLACK BEAR HUNTING
- 24 STAMP, THE APPLICATION FEE FOR THE LOTTERY WILL BE APPLIED TO THE FEE FOR
- 25 THE BLACK BEAR HUNTING STAMP;
- 26 (6) PROVIDE FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF BLACK BEAR HUNTING STAMPS
- 27 AND ALLOW AN AGENT SELLING BLACK BEAR HUNTING STAMPS TO RETAIN AN
- 28 AMOUNT SET BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR THE COST OF THE STAMP; AND
- 29 (7) ESTABLISH THE FEE FOR BLACK BEAR HUNTING STAMPS AT A LEVEL
- 30 THAT THE DEPARTMENT BELIEVES WILL GENERATE ADEQUATE REVENUE IN THE
- 31 STATE WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AND PROTECTION FUND TO MEET THE BLACK BEAR
- 32 MANAGEMENT NEEDS OF THE STATE.
- 33 (D) A PERSON MAY HUNT BLACK BEAR ON PRIVATE LAND ONLY IF CARRYING
- 34 THE WRITTEN PERMISSION OF THE OWNER OF THE LAND OR OTHER PERSON
- 35 DESIGNATED BY THE OWNER OF THE LAND, IF THE LAND IS OWNED OR LEASED BY A
- 36 PERSON OTHER THAN THE PERSON HUNTING.

- 1 (E) TO THE EXTENT POSSIBLE, A MINIMUM OF 10% OF THE BLACK BEAR
- 2 HUNTING STAMPS ISSUED IN A COUNTY WHERE HUNTING IS TO TAKE PLACE SHALL
- 3 BE AWARDED TO COUNTY RESIDENTS.
- 4 (F) ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2002, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL FULLY
- 5 IMPLEMENT THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 6 (G) A LOTTERY FOR PURPOSES OF DISTRIBUTING BLACK BEAR HUNTING
- 7 STAMPS UNDER THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED TO BE A LOTTERY UNDER
- 8 ARTICLE III, SECTION 36 OF THE CONSTITUTION OR § 12-203 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW
- 9 ARTICLE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 11 June 1, 2002.
