19 (a) (1) No person shall engage in the business of selling, renting, or

20 transferring regulated firearms unless he lawfully possesses and conspicuously

21 displays at his place of business, in addition to any other license required by law, a

22 regulated firearms dealer's license issued by the Secretary. Such license shall identify

23 the licensee and the location of the licensee's place of business. One such license shall

24 be required for each place of business where regulated firearms are sold.

(2) (I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS
PARAGRAPH, THE SECRETARY MAY NOT ISSUE A REGULATED FIREARMS DEALER'S
