15 16	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- THE AUTHORITY TO BRING SUIT AND THE RIGHT TO RECOVER 20 (A) (1)
- 21 AGAINST ANY GUN MANUFACTURER OR DEALER BY OR ON BEHALF OF ANY
- 22 POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT AUTHORITY FOR DAMAGES,
- 23 ABATEMENT, OR INJUNCTIVE RELIEF RESULTING FROM OR RELATING TO THE
