CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Juvenile Justice - Criminal History Record Information - Dissemination**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Criminal Justice Information System Central
4 Repository to disseminate certain criminal history record information regarding
5 certain unique identifiers of certain children to the Maryland Justice Analysis
6 Center; prohibiting the Maryland Justice Analysis Center from disseminating
7 certain criminal history record information except under a certain circumstance;
8 and generally relating to the dissemination of criminal history record
9 information.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article - Criminal Procedure**

18 10-219.

19 (a) Except in accordance with applicable federal law and regulations, a
20 criminal justice unit and the Central Repository may not disseminate criminal history
21 record information.

1 (b) (1) The Central Repository shall disseminate on a monthly basis
2 information concerning a child charged as an adult to the Maryland Justice Analysis
3 Center of the Institute of Criminal Justice and Criminology of the University of
4 Maryland.

5 (2) In addition to any reportable event, as defined in § 10-215 of this
6 subtitle, the Central Repository shall include in its dissemination of information to
7 the Maryland Justice Analysis Center the age, race, and gender of the child.

8 (3) The Central Repository may [not] disseminate to the Maryland
9 Justice Analysis Center [any] unique identifiers relating to the child, including the
10 name of the child, fingerprint identification numbers, and record or file numbers.

11 (4) The information disseminated to the Maryland Justice Analysis
12 Center in accordance with this subsection shall be used only for the purposes of
13 research, evaluation, and statistical analysis.

14 (5) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE REQUIRED UNDER STATE LAW, THE
15 MARYLAND JUSTICE ANALYSIS CENTER MAY NOT DISSEMINATE CRIMINAL HISTORY
16 RECORD INFORMATION RECEIVED FROM THE CENTRAL REPOSITORY.

17 [(5)] (6) By June 30 and December 31 of each year, the Maryland Justice
18 Analysis Center shall report to the Governor, and, subject to § 2-1246 of the State
19 Government Article, the General Assembly, on the results of its research, evaluation,
20 and statistical analysis.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
22 October 1, 2002.
