- 21 (B) AN INMATE MAY NOT WILLFULLY AND INTENTIONALLY INDECENTLY
- 22 EXPOSE PRIVATE PARTS OF THE INMATE'S BODY IN THE PRESENCE OF A
- 23 CORRECTIONAL OFFICER OR AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.
