CHAPTER\_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County - State's Attorney - Salary**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the State's Attorney for Frederick County;  
4 providing that this Act does not apply to the salary or compensation of the  
5 incumbent State's Attorney for Frederick County; and generally relating to the  
6 salary of the State's Attorney for Frederick County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
8 Article 10 - Legal Officials  
9 Section 40(k)(1)  
10 Annotated Code of Maryland  
11 (2001 Replacement Volume)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 10 - Legal Officials**

15 40.

16 (k) (1) In Frederick County, the State's Attorney's annual salary shall be  
17 [80] 90% of the salary of a judge of the District Court of Maryland.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,  
19 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or  
20 apply to the salary or compensation of the State's Attorney for Frederick County in  
21 office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the

1 salary or compensation of the State's Attorney for Frederick County shall take effect  
2 at the beginning of the next following term of office.

3 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
4 October 1, 2002.
