3 FOR the purpose of altering the manner by which certain employees in the office of

- 4 the Frederick County State's Attorney are appointed; providing that, subject to

- 7 relating to the appointment of employees in the office of the Frederick County

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 10 - Legal Officials

18 (k) (1) In Frederick County, the State's Attorney's annual salary shall be 80 19 percent of the salary of a judge of the District Court of Maryland.

20 (2) The State's Attorney may appoint a member of the bar of Frederick

21 County as deputy State's Attorney, to serve at the pleasure of the State's Attorney.

22 The deputy State's Attorney's annual salary shall be set by the State's Attorney,

1 subject to the approval of the County Commissioners. Under the direction of the

2 State's Attorney, the deputy State's Attorney shall present cases to the grand jury and

3 perform such other acts and duties in relation to the grand jury and in the operation

4 of the office as are necessary and proper.

5 (3) The State's Attorney and deputy State's Attorney may not engage in 6 the private practice of law.

7 (4) The Board of County Commissioners shall provide an office in the 8 courthouse for the State's Attorney. The Board shall pay the expenses of the office, 9 including general operating expenses, cost of equipment, and the reasonable salary of 10 a stenographer to be appointed by the State's Attorney.

(5) The State's Attorney may appoint the number of full or part-time
assistant State's Attorneys and other staff personnel as may be approved by the
County Commissioners. [All such appointees] THE DEPUTY STATE'S ATTORNEY,
ASSISTANT STATE'S ATTORNEYS, THE CHIEF OF STAFF, AND THE SENIOR CHIEF
INVESTIGATOR shall serve at the State's Attorney's pleasure. ALL OTHER EMPLOYEES
APPOINTED BY THE STATE'S ATTORNEY SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE COUNTY
PERSONNEL REGULATIONS. The salaries and compensation of [such persons] ALL
EMPLOYEES WITHIN THE STATE'S ATTORNEY'S OFFICE shall be as approved by the
County Commissioners. The assistant State's Attorneys shall have the same legal
powers as the State's Attorney to present cases to the grand jury and perform such
other acts and duties in relation to the grand jury and in the operations of the office

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 24 October 1, 2002.
