24 25	(A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO A COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION THAT OFFERS COVERAGE FOR HEALTH BENEFITS TO THE EMPLOYEES OF THE COUNTY OR

26 MUNICIPAL CORPORATION UNDER A GROUP HEALTH BENEFIT PLAN.

- 1 (B) A COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION MAY
- 2 ALLOW RESIDENTS OF THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION WHO ARE NOT
- 3 EMPLOYEES OF THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE
- 4 GROUP HEALTH BENEFIT PLAN SUBJECT TO THE CONDITIONS OF THIS SECTION.
- 5 (C) A RESIDENT OF THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION SUBJECT TO
- 6 THIS SECTION WHO IS NOT AN EMPLOYEE OF THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL
- 7 CORPORATION MAY PARTICIPATE IN THE GROUP HEALTH BENEFIT PLAN OF THE
- 8 COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION ONLY IF THE INDIVIDUAL HAS BEEN A
- 9 RESIDENT OF THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION FOR AT LEAST 1 YEAR.
- 10 (D) IF A RESIDENT OF THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION CHOOSES
- 11 TO PARTICIPATE IN THE GROUP HEALTH BENEFIT PLAN, THE RESIDENT SHALL PAY
- 12 THE FULL COST OF THE PREMIUM WITH NO SUBSIDY FROM THE COUNTY OR
- 13 MUNICIPAL CORPORATION.
- 14 (E) THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION MAY CHARGE AN
- 15 ADMINISTRATIVE FEE OF UP TO \$25 PER YEAR TO ADMINISTER THE ACCOUNT OF A
- 16 RESIDENT OF THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION WHO PARTICIPATES IN
- 17 THE GROUP HEALTH BENEFIT PLAN.
