13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 Article - Commercial Law

16 14-1501.

- 17 (c) [(1)] "Motor vehicle" means a vehicle that is registered in this State as a:
- 18 [(i)] (1) Class A (passenger) vehicle;
- 19 [(ii)] (2) Class D (motorcycle) vehicle;
- 20 [(iii)] (3) Class E (truck) vehicle with a 3/4 ton or less
- 21 manufacturer's rated capacity; or
- [(iv)] (4) Class M (multipurpose) vehicle.
- 23 [(2) "Motor vehicle" does not include a motor home. For the purpose of
- 24 administering this subtitle, the Motor Vehicle Administration shall promulgate a
- 25 regulation defining a motor home.]

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 2002.
