13	MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
14	Article 10 - Legal Officials

16 17	(h) (1) (i) In Cecil County, the State's Attorney's salary shall be 95 percent of a District Court judge's salary.
18 19	(ii) The State's Attorney may not engage in the private practice of law during the State's Attorney's term of office.
20 21	(iii) The State's Attorney shall devote full time to the duties of the office.

- 1 In addition to the compensation provided for in this section, the (iv) 2 State's Attorney for the operation of his office and the performance of his duties, shall 3 be entitled to a reasonable expense allowance which shall be as provided for in the 4 Cecil County budget. 5 The State's Attorney may appoint one deputy and such assistant (2) 6 State's Attorneys as are provided for in the Cecil County budget to serve part time at 7 the pleasure of the State's Attorney. The salary of the deputy State's Attorney and the 8 assistant State's Attorneys shall be as provided for in the Cecil County budget. 9 The deputy State's Attorney and the assistant State's Attorneys shall 10 have the same legal powers as the State's Attorney to represent the State before 11 grand juries and in the trial of criminal proceedings. 12 (4) The State's Attorney may appoint clerical, secretarial, 13 administrative, and other assistants as the State's Attorney deems necessary for the 14 proper conduct of the office. The salaries for these positions shall be as provided for in 15 the Cecil County budget. THESE EMPLOYEES SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE CECIL 16 COUNTY PERSONNEL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES GOVERNING COUNTY 17 EMPLOYEES. 18 The State's Attorney is the appointing authority for all employees of 19 that office and [they] ALL EMPLOYEES EXCEPT THOSE SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (4) 20 ABOVE shall serve at the pleasure of the State's Attorney. 21 The State's Attorney, deputy State's Attorney, and assistant State's 22 Attorneys shall be entitled to all benefits received by full-time employees of Cecil 23 County. 24 (7)The State's Attorney's allowance for special work and employment of
- 25 extra help is \$1,500 a year, to be spent only with the approval of the Administrative
- 26 Judge of the Circuit Court for Cecil County.
- 27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
