- 2 shall report to the General Assembly on or before September 30, 2002, in accordance
- 3 with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, on any available federal funding,
- 4 including the amount, for the grants to be awarded under this Act.
- 5 SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 4 of this Act shall
- 6 take effect July 1, 2002. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end
- 7 of June 30, 2003, with no further action required by the General Assembly, Section 4
- 8 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
- 9 SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, except as provided in
- 10 Section 5 of this Act and contingent on a report by the Secretary of Aging that federal
- 11 funding is available as described under Section 4 of this Act, this Act shall take effect
- 12 October 1, 2002. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and 11 months and, at
- 13 the end of August 31, 2005, with no further action required by the General Assembly,
- 14 this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
