CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Education - Harford County ~~Public~~ Public Library Board of Trustees**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the number of members on the Harford County Public
4 Library Board of ~~Library~~ Trustees; requiring the members of the Board to be
5 appointed on a fiscal year basis; and generally relating to the Harford County
6 ~~Board of Public~~ Library Board of Trustees.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

2 23-403.

3 (a) (1) [Each] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS
4 SUBSECTION, EACH board of library trustees consists of seven members appointed by
5 the county governing body from nominees submitted by the board of library trustees.

6 (2) A board that existed before 1945 under a corporate charter may
7 continue as constituted if:

8 (i) It has at least seven members;

9 (ii) The members are chosen on the basis of character, ability, and
10 demonstrated interest in library matters; and

11 (iii) The members meet the qualifications required under subsection
12 (b) of this section.

13 (3) IN HARFORD COUNTY, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES CONSISTS OF ~~UP TO~~
14 AT LEAST 7 MEMBERS, BUT NOT MORE THAN 11 MEMBERS, APPOINTED BY THE
15 COUNTY GOVERNING BODY FROM NOMINEES SUBMITTED BY THE BOARD OF
16 TRUSTEES.

17 (b) The members of the board shall be:

18 (1) Representative of the area the library serves; and

19 (2) Residents of the county that the library serves.

20 (c) (1) Except as provided in [subsection (d)] SUBSECTIONS (D) AND (E) of
21 this section, a member of a board serves for a term of 5 years and until a successor is
22 appointed and qualifies. These terms are staggered as required by the terms of the
23 members serving on the board as of July 1, 1978.

24 (2) Except as provided in paragraph (4) of this subsection, a member may
25 be reappointed but may not serve more than two consecutive terms.

26 (3) A member appointed to fill a vacancy in an unexpired term:

27 (i) Serves only for the remainder of that term and until a successor
28 is appointed and qualifies; and

29 (ii) Is eligible for appointment to serve two additional consecutive
30 terms.

31 (4) A member of the board of the Prince George's County Memorial
32 Library System may serve an unlimited number of consecutive terms of office.

33 (d) In Charles County, a member of the board serves for a term of 4 years.

1 (e) IN HARFORD COUNTY, A MEMBER OF THE BOARD SERVES FOR A TERM OF
2 5 YEARS, BEGINNING ON JULY 1, AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND
3 QUALIFIES.

4 (F) Each member of a board serves without compensation.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
6 effect July 1, 2002.
