- 9 individuals not licensed; providing certain penalties for certain violations;
- 10 defining certain terms; and generally relating to licensed graduate marriage

22 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

 TYPES OF LICENSES ISSUED BY THE BOARD AUTHORIZING AN INDIVIDUAL TO

5 (2) CLINICAL MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPY;

17 [(c)] (E) "Practice clinical alcohol and drug counseling" means to engage 18 professionally and for compensation in alcohol and drug counseling and appraisal 19 activities by providing services involving the application of counseling principles and 20 methods in the diagnosis, prevention, treatment, and amelioration of psychological 21 problems[,] AND emotional or mental conditions of individuals or groups.

[(d)] (F) "Practice clinical marriage and family therapy" means to engage
professionally and for compensation in marriage and family therapy and appraisal
activities by providing services involving the application of therapy principles and
methods in the diagnosis, prevention, treatment, and amelioration of psychological
problems[,] AND emotional or mental conditions of individuals or groups.

[(e)] (G) "Practice clinical professional counseling" means to engage
professionally and for compensation in counseling and appraisal activities by
providing services involving the application of counseling principles and methods in
the diagnosis, prevention, treatment, and amelioration of psychological problems[,]
AND emotional or mental conditions of individuals or groups.

(A) THE BOARD MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO ALLOW AN INDIVIDUAL TO
PRACTICE UNDER SUPERVISION AS A LICENSED GRADUATE PROFESSIONAL
COUNSELOR OR A LICENSED GRADUATE MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPIST.

(B) TO QUALIFY TO PRACTICE AS A LICENSED GRADUATE PROFESSIONAL
 COUNSELOR OR A LICENSED GRADUATE MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPIST, AN
 INDIVIDUAL SHALL BE:

4 (1) OF GOOD MORAL CHARACTER; AND

5 (2) AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD.

6 (C) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY PRACTICE PROFESSIONAL COUNSELING AS A 7 LICENSED GRADUATE PROFESSIONAL COUNSELOR WITHOUT LICENSURE FOR A 8 LIMITED PERIOD OF TIME IF THE INDIVIDUAL:

9 (1) HAS PASSED THE NATIONAL PROFESSIONAL COUNSELOR 10 EXAMINATION APPROVED BY THE BOARD;

(2) IS UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A LICENSED CLINICAL
 PROFESSIONAL COUNSELOR OR ANOTHER HEALTH CARE PROVIDER LICENSED
 UNDER THIS ARTICLE, AS APPROVED BY THE BOARD; AND

18 (1) HAS PASSED THE NATIONAL MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPY19 EXAMINATION APPROVED BY THE BOARD;

20 (2) IS UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A LICENSED CLINICAL MARRIAGE 21 AND FAMILY THERAPIST OR ANOTHER HEALTH CARE PROVIDER LICENSED UNDER 22 THIS ARTICLE, AS APPROVED BY THE BOARD; AND

23 (3) IS FULFILLING THE REQUIREMENTS FOR SUPERVISED EXPERIENCE 24 UNDER § 17-3A-02 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(E) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY PROVIDE COUNSELING UNDER SUPERVISION AS
PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION IF THE INDIVIDUAL HAS A MASTER'S OR DOCTORAL
DEGREE IN A PROFESSIONAL COUNSELING FIELD THAT MEETS THE EDUCATIONAL
REQUIREMENTS OF § 17-3A-02 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

29 (F) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY PROVIDE MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPY UNDER
30 SUPERVISION AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION IF THE INDIVIDUAL HAS A MASTER'S
31 OR DOCTORAL DEGREE IN A MARRIAGE AND FAMILY FIELD THAT MEETS THE

 2 AS A LICENSED GRADUATE PROFESSIONAL COUNSELOR OR A LICENSED GRADUATE
 3 MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPIST BEFORE THE INDIVIDUAL MAY:

4 (I) USE THE TITLE "LICENSED GRADUATE PROFESSIONAL 5 COUNSELOR" OR "LICENSED GRADUATE MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPIST";

6 (II) USE THE INITIALS "L.G.P.C." OR "L.G.M.F.T." AFTER THE NAME OF 7 THE INDIVIDUAL;

8 (III) REPRESENT TO THE PUBLIC THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS 9 APPROVED BY THE BOARD TO PRACTICE PROFESSIONAL COUNSELING OR MARRIAGE 10 AND FAMILY THERAPY; OR

(IV) USE ANY TITLE, ABBREVIATION, SIGN, CARD, OR OTHER
 REPRESENTATION THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS A LICENSED GRADUATE PROFESSIONAL
 COUNSELOR OR A LICENSED GRADUATE MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPIST.

14 (H) ANY INDIVIDUAL WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (G) OF THIS SECTION IS
15 GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT
16 EXCEEDING \$500 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 6 MONTHS OR BOTH.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 18 October 1, 2002.
