CONSENT TO AN ABORTION IS VOLUNTARY AND INFORMED IF AT LEAST 18 6 7 HOURS PRIOR TO THE ABORTION, THE PHYSICIAN WHO IS TO PERFORM THE ABORTION OR THE REFERRING PHYSICIAN HAS INFORMED THE WOMAN OF: THE NATURE OF THE PROPOSED PROCEDURE; 9 (1) 10 (2) THE RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH THE PROCEDURE: (3) ALTERNATIVES TO THE PROCEDURE THAT A REASONABLE WOMAN 11 12 WOULD CONSIDER MATERIAL TO MAKING THE DECISION TO HAVE AN ABORTION; THE PROBABLE GESTATIONAL AGE OF THE FETUS ON THE DATE THE 13 (4) 14 ABORTION IS TO BE PERFORMED: AND 15 THE MEDICAL RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH A FULL-TERM PREGNANCY. A PHYSICIAN WHO VIOLATES A PROVISION OF § 21-211 OR § 21-212 OF THIS 16 (A) 17 SUBTITLE IS SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINARY ACTION UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF § 14-404 18 OF THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE. 19 A PHYSICIAN MAY NOT BE FOUND IN VIOLATION OF § 21-211 OR § 21-212 OF 20 THIS SUBTITLE FOR FAILURE TO PROVIDE THE REQUIRED INFORMATION IF THE 21 PHYSICIAN CERTIFIES IN THE PATIENT'S MEDICAL RECORDS THAT THE ABORTION 22 WAS NECESSARY TO PREVENT THE DEATH OF THE PATIENT. 23 **Article - Health Occupations** 24 14-404. Subject to the hearing provisions of § 14-405 of this subtitle, the Board, on 25 (a) 26 the affirmative vote of a majority of its full authorized membership, may reprimand 27 any licensee, place any licensee on probation, or suspend or revoke a license if the 28 licensee: 29 Intentionally misrepresents credentials for the purpose of testifying 30 or rendering an expert opinion in hearings or proceedings before the Board or those 31 otherwise delegated to the Office of Administrative Hearings; [or] Fails to keep adequate medical records as determined by appropriate 32 (40)
