

 4 (a) Except as otherwise provided in § 16-202(b) of this subtitle, a person may 5 not act, attempt to act, or offer to act as a [manufacturer] CIGARETTE NONRESIDENT 6 DEALER, retailer, storage warehouse, subwholesaler, vending machine operator, or 7 wholesaler in the State unless the person has an appropriate license.
- 8 (b) (1) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and, on 9 conviction, is subject to a fine of \$1,000 or imprisonment not exceeding 30 days or 10 both.
- 11 (2) Each day that a violation of this section continues is a separate 12 offense.
- 13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 14 October 1, 2002.
