CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Police Retirement System - DROP - Eligibility and Participation**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing certain eligibility requirements that certain members of
4 the State Police Retirement System must meet to participate in the Deferred
5 Retirement Option Program (DROP); repealing certain limitations on the length
6 of time certain members of the State Police Retirement System may participate
7 in the DROP; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to
8 eligibility and participation in the DROP for members of the State Police
9 Retirement System.

10 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
11 Article - State Personnel and Pensions
12 Section 24-401.1(c) and (d)
13 Annotated Code of Maryland
14 (1997 Replacement Volume and 2001 Supplement)

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article - State Personnel and Pensions**

18 24-401.1.

19 (c) [(1) Except for the Secretary of the State Police, a] A member of the State
20 Police Retirement System is eligible to participate in the DROP if the member:

21 [(i) (1) has at least 22 [and less than 28] years of eligibility
22 service; and

1 [(ii)] (2) is less than 60 years old.

2 [(2) The Secretary of the State Police is eligible to participate in the
3 DROP if the Secretary has at least 22 years of eligibility service.]

4 (d) An eligible member may elect to participate in the DROP for a period not
5 to exceed the lesser of:

6 (1) 4 years;

7 (2) [the difference between 28 years and the member's eligibility service
8 as of the date of the member's election to participate in the DROP and retire from the
9 State Police Retirement System;

10 (3)] the difference between age 60 and the member's age as of the date of
11 the member's election to participate in the DROP and retire from the State Police
12 Retirement System; or

13 [(4)] (3) a term selected by the member.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
15 construed to apply retroactively and shall be applied to and interpreted to affect any
16 individual ~~who is a member of the State Police Retirement System and~~ who joined the
17 DROP on or after July 1, 1999 and is a member of the DROP on the effective date of
18 this Act.

19 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
20 July 1, 2002.
