11 12	(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
15 16 17	(2) "EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS" MEANS THE PREREQUISITE COURSE OF STUDY, ACADEMIC CREDIT HOURS, AND FORMAL DEGREE AWARDS NECESSARY TO SATISFY THE MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR LICENSURE OR CERTIFICATION IN A PROFESSION OR AN OCCUPATION ESTABLISHED BY A LICENSING OR CERTIFYING ENTITY UNDER THE BUSINESS OCCUPATIONS AND PROFESSIONS ARTICLE.
21	(3) "PRACTICAL MASTERS PROGRAM" MEANS A PROGRAM THAT OFFERS GRADUATE LEVEL COURSES TO SATISFY THE EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS BEYOND THE BACCALAUREATE LEVEL TO QUALIFY FOR LICENSURE OR CERTIFICATION IN A PROFESSION OR AN OCCUPATION.

1	(b) AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION MATESTABLISH A GRADUATE
2	PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATE PROGRAM IF THE INSTITUTION OFFERS A DEGREE
3	PROGRAM DIRECTLY RELATED TO THE AREA OF LICENSURE OR CERTIFICATION.
4	(C) (1) THE PRESIDENT OF AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL
5	NOTIFY THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE INSTITUTION AND THE COMMISSION OF
6	THE INSTITUTION'S INTENT TO OFFER A GRADUATE PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATE
7	PROGRAM.
8	(2) THE PROGRAM SHALL BE APPROVED BY THE COMMISSION AND
9	IMPLEMENTED CONSISTENT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
10	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
11	effect October 1, 2002, contingent on the taking effect of Chapter (S.B. 85/H.B.
12	731) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2002, and if Chapter does not become
13	effective, this Act shall be null and void without the necessity of further action by the
14	General Assembly.
