SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

## 1 **Article - Education** 2 11-206.2. IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS (A) (1)4 INDICATED. "EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS" MEANS THE PREREQUISITE 5 6 COURSE OF STUDY, ACADEMIC CREDIT HOURS, AND FORMAL DEGREE AWARDS 7 NECESSARY TO SATISFY THE MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR LICENSURE OR 8 CERTIFICATION IN A PROFESSION OR AN OCCUPATION ESTABLISHED BY A 9 LICENSING OR CERTIFYING ENTITY UNDER THE BUSINESS OCCUPATIONS AND 10 PROFESSIONS ARTICLE. "PRACTICAL MASTERS PROGRAM" MEANS A PROGRAM THAT OFFERS 12 GRADUATE LEVEL COURSES TO SATISFY THE EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS 13 BEYOND THE BACCALAUREATE LEVEL TO QUALIFY FOR LICENSURE OR 14 CERTIFICATION IN A PROFESSION OR AN OCCUPATION. SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE INSTITUTION'S GOVERNING BOARD 15 16 AS PROVIDED IN § 11-206.1(B) OF THIS SUBTITLE, A CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION OF 17 THE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM OF MARYLAND THAT OFFERS A COURSE OF 18 UNDERGRADUATE STUDY IN A DEGREE PROGRAM THAT SATISFIES THE 19 EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS UP TO THE BACCALAUREATE LEVEL OF A 20 PROFESSION OR OCCUPATION, MAY ESTABLISH A PRACTICAL MASTERS PROGRAM. IN THIS SECTION, "GRADUATE PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATE PROGRAM" 22 MEANS A PROGRAM THAT: 23 (1) OFFERS AND AWARDS A GRADUATE CERTIFICATE FOR SUCCESSFUL 24 COMPLETION OF THE NUMBER OF COURSES REQUIRED BY THE APPROPRIATE 25 NATIONAL PROFESSIONAL ASSOCIATION OR STATE LICENSURE OR CERTIFICATION 26 BOARD FOR BUSINESS AND HEALTH PROFESSIONS AND OCCUPATIONS; AND SATISFIES THE REQUIREMENTS BEYOND THE BACCALAUREATE 28 LEVEL FOR LICENSURE OR CERTIFICATION IN A PROFESSION OR OCCUPATION. AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION MAY ESTABLISH A GRADUATE 30 PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATE PROGRAM IF THE INSTITUTION OFFERS A DEGREE 31 PROGRAM DIRECTLY RELATED TO THE AREA OF LICENSURE OR CERTIFICATION. THE PRESIDENT OF AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL 32 33 NOTIFY THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE INSTITUTION AND THE COMMISSION OF

34 THE INSTITUTION'S INTENT TO OFFER A GRADUATE PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATE

37 IMPLEMENTED CONSISTENT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

THE PROGRAM SHALL BE APPROVED BY THE COMMISSION AND

- 1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 2 effect October 1, 2002, contingent on the taking effect of Chapter \_\_\_\_\_ (S.B. 85) of the 3 Acts of the General Assembly of 2002, and if Chapter \_\_\_\_\_ does not become effective, 4 this Act shall be null and void without the necessity of further action by the General

- 5 Assembly.
