- 19 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "MAS" MEANS THE MARYLAND ADOLESCENT SURVEY
- 20 SPONSORED BY THE MARYLAND STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, DEPARTMENT
- 21 OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE, AND DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION THAT
- 22 IS GIVEN TO SIXTH, EIGHTH, TENTH, AND TWELFTH GRADE STUDENTS IN MARYLAND
- 23 TO ESTIMATE SUBSTANCE ABUSE AMONG ADOLESCENTS.
- 24 (B) BEFORE A PUBLIC MIDDLE OR PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL ADMINISTERS THE
- 25 MAS TO ITS STUDENTS, THE SCHOOL SHALL:
- 26 (1) PROVIDE THE PARENTS OR GUARDIAN OF PARTICIPATING STUDENTS
