3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Comptroller to distribute certain unanticipated

4 lottery revenues to all the public school systems in the State; specifying that the

5 money distributed under this Act is intended to provide additional revenue for

6 public school systems and may not supplant any other appropriation to public

7 school systems; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the distribution

8 of lottery proceeds to public school systems in the State.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 (a) The Comptroller shall distribute the State Lottery Fund to pay:

19 (1) on a pro rata basis for the daily and nondaily State lottery games, the 20 expenses of administering and operating the State lottery, as authorized under this 21 subtitle and the State budget; and

22 (2) then, except as provided in § 10-113.1 of the Family Law Article and 23 § 11-618 of the Criminal Procedure Article, the holder of each winning ticket or share.

24(b)(1)[Promptly] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS25SECTION, PROMPTLY after the 1st day of each month, the Comptroller shall pay:

1 (i) into the Maryland Stadium Facilities Fund the money that

2 remains in the State Lottery Fund from the proceeds of the sports lotteries conducted

3 for the benefit of the Maryland Stadium Authority, after the distribution under

ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION SCHOOLS UNDER THE CONTROL OF A
COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION OR THE NEW BALTIMORE CITY BOARD OF SCHOOL
COMMISSIONERS.

17 (III) "UNANTICIPATED REVENUES" MEANS STATE LOTTERY
18 REVENUES THAT EXCEED BUDGETARY PROJECTIONS FOR A FISCAL YEAR.

19(2)IF THE STATE LOTTERY RECEIVES UNANTICIPATED REVENUES FOR20A FISCAL YEAR, THE COMPTROLLER:

21(I)MAY NOT TRANSFER ANY OF THOSE REVENUES TO THE22GENERAL FUND; AND

(II) SHALL DISTRIBUTE TO EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM THE
 REVENUES ON A PRO RATA BASIS ACCORDING TO THE TOTAL LOTTERY SALES MADE
 IN THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM IS LOCATED.

(3) A DISTRIBUTION UNDER THIS SUBSECTION IS INTENDED TO
PROVIDE ADDITIONAL REVENUE FOR A PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM AND MAY NOT
SUPPLANT ANY OTHER DISTRIBUTION OF LOTTERY PROCEEDS TO THE PUBLIC
SCHOOL SYSTEMS.

30 [(c)] (D) The regulations of the Agency shall apportion the money in the State 31 Lottery Fund.

32 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 33 October 1, 2002.
