1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Environment - Well Drilling Permits - Exemptions**

3 FOR the purpose of exempting certain persons who drill wells to conduct temporary
4 dewatering under certain circumstances from a certain prohibition against
5 drilling a well without a permit; and generally relating to permits to drill wells.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Environment**

14 9-1306.

15 (A) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A PERSON WHO DRILLS A WELL TO
16 CONDUCT TEMPORARY DEWATERING BY USE OF WELL POINTS, DEEP WELLS, OR
17 SIMILAR METHODS OF DEWATERING TO INSTALL UNDERGROUND UTILITIES.

18 (B) A person may not drill a well in this State unless the Department issues a
19 permit to drill the well.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
21 October 1, 2002.
