- 15 (a) (1) The Commission consists of the following 29 members:
- 16 (i) as an ex officio member, the Chairman of the Maryland
- 17 Veterans' Home Commission; and
- 18 (ii) 28 members appointed by the Governor.
- 19 (2) Of the 28 appointed members:
- 20 (i) 1 shall be appointed from each of the 8 congressional districts in
- 21 the State:
- 22 (ii) 1 shall be a veteran of World War II, appointed from the State
- 23 at large;
- 24 (iii) 1 shall be a representative of a women veterans organization in

24 (b) Each member must be a resident of the State and a veteran whose final 25 separation from active service with a uniformed service of the United States was 26 under honorable conditions.		
27 (c) (1) The ter	The term of an appointed member is 7 years.	
28 (2) The terms of the appointed members are staggered as required by the 29 terms provided for members of the Commission on October 1, 1984.		

- 1 (3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is 2 appointed and qualifies.
- 3 (4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for 4 the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 2002.
