12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 24 - Political Subdivisions - Miscellaneous Provisions**

16 (o) (±) In addition to and not in substitution for any powers granted under
17 this subtitle, the county commissioners of Dorchester, Garrett, and Somerset counties
18 may by ordinance provide for a comprehensive system for the regulation of dogs and
19 cats within the county, including licensing and control. These regulations may include
20 provision for the impounding and disposal of unlicensed or dangerous dogs and cats
21 and penalties, INCLUDING IN DORCHESTER COUNTY CIVIL OR CRIMINAL PENALTIES,
22 for violations of any of the provisions of the regulations.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
5 October 1, 2002.
