A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2                           **Public Lodging - Individuals with Disabilities - Accessible Rooms and**  
3                           **Platform Lifts**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring a certain place of public lodging to provide a certain  
5 accessible room to an individual with a disability; requiring a certain place of  
6 public lodging to install a platform lift on every other floor; requiring the  
7 implementation of training for personnel in certain places of public lodging  
8 regarding the operation of a platform lift; requiring certain staff to note the use  
9 of an accessible room by an individual with a disability in order to advise  
10 emergency personnel in certain circumstances; defining certain terms;  
11 amending a certain title; and generally relating to the accommodation of  
12 individuals with disabilities in places of public lodging.

13 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

24 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
25 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - Business Regulation**

Title 15. Hotels AND OTHER PLACES OF PUBLIC LODGING.

3 15-102.

4 Except for [§ 15-105] §§ 15-105 AND 15-108 of this title, this title applies only to  
5 those hotels that display in each guest room a notice of the provisions of this title.

6 15-108.

7 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS  
8 INDICATED.

9 (2) "ACCESSIBLE ROOM" MEANS A ROOM IN A PLACE OF PUBLIC  
10 LODGING CONSISTENT WITH THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT  
11 ACCESSIBILITY GUIDELINES FOR BUILDINGS AND FACILITIES.

12 (3) "FRONT DESK STAFF" INCLUDES A MANAGER, ASSISTANT MANAGER,  
13 CONCIERGE, DESK CLERK, OR ANY OTHER MEMBER OF THE STAFF OF A PLACE OF  
14 PUBLIC LODGING WHO KNOWS OR HAS REASON TO KNOW THAT AN INDIVIDUAL  
15 WITH A DISABILITY REQUIRING AN ACCESSIBLE ROOM IS CHECKING INTO THE  
16 ESTABLISHMENT.

17 (4) "PLACE OF PUBLIC LODGING" INCLUDES A HOTEL, INN, MOTEL, AND  
18 ANY OTHER ESTABLISHMENT WHICH PROVIDES PUBLIC LODGING FOR TRANSIENT  
19 GUESTS AND HAS FOUR FLOORS OR MORE.

20 (5) "PLATFORM LIFT" MEANS AN INCLINED STAIRWAY LIFT WITH  
21 LIMITED VERTICAL TRAVEL, OPERATING SPEED, AND PLATFORM AREA INTENDED  
22 FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF A MOBILITY IMPAIRED PERSON UP OR DOWN ONE  
23 FLIGHT OF STAIRS.

24 (B) A PLACE OF PUBLIC LODGING SHALL:

25 (1) PROVIDE AN ACCESSIBLE ROOM THAT IS LOCATED ON THE SIXTH  
26 FLOOR OR BELOW TO AN INDIVIDUAL WITH A DISABILITY;

27 (2) ACQUIRE A PLATFORM LIFT FOR EVERY OTHER FLOOR; AND

28 (3) IMPLEMENT TRAINING FOR PERSONNEL REGARDING:

29 (I) HOW TO OPERATE A PLATFORM LIFT PURSUANT TO  
30 SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION; AND

31 (II) HOW TO BEST ASSIST AN INDIVIDUAL WITH DISABILITIES IN  
32 THE EVENT OF EVACUATION.

33 (C) OPERATION OF A PLATFORM LIFT SHALL BE UNDER THE CONTINUOUS  
34 CONTROL OF THE USER OR ATTENDANT AND SHALL BE CONSISTENT WITH THE

1 AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT ACCESSIBILITY GUIDELINES FOR BUILDINGS  
2 AND FACILITIES.

3 (D) FRONT DESK STAFF SHALL:

4 (1) FIRST OFFER AN ACCESSIBLE ROOM ON THE FIRST FLOOR, IF  
5 UNOCCUPIED, TO AN INDIVIDUAL WITH A DISABILITY WHO REQUIRES AN  
6 ACCESSIBLE ROOM BEFORE OFFERING THE INDIVIDUAL A ROOM ON ANOTHER  
7 FLOOR; AND

8 (2) NOTE THE USE OF A ROOM ON ANY FLOOR BY AN INDIVIDUAL WITH A  
9 DISABILITY WHO REQUIRES AN ACCESSIBLE ROOM IN ORDER TO ADVISE  
10 EMERGENCY PERSONNEL OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S LOCATION IN THE EVENT OF  
11 EVACUATION.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
13 October 1, 2002.
