4 FOR the purpose of requiring certain facilities to disclose certain information about

5 the services of certain Alzheimer's Special Care Units or Programs; requiring

6 certain disclosures be made to certain persons and a certain office in the

7 Department of Health and Mental Hygiene; requiring that all disclosures made

8 to a certain office be in writing; requiring that certain disclosures made to

9 certain persons be in writing, if requested requiring a certain description be

10 made in writing at a certain time; requiring disclosure of the written description

11 <u>to certain persons;</u> requiring the Unit or Program making certain disclosures to

12 include certain information; requiring the Office of Health Care Quality to

13 examine and verify the accuracy of certain records as part of certain facility's

14 license renewal procedure; requiring the Office of Health Care Quality to take

15 certain actions if the Office makes certain findings authorizing the Department
